

- Hundred weight sacks of marble chips imported through the docks.
- **2** Late 1970's.
  - The lock buildings were a stable, a forge and a rest room for canal workers.

    The lock keepers cottage was on the opposite side of the canal.
- Pharmaceutical company British Drug
  Houses built these factories in 1909, as
  well as a factory on Wenlock Basin.

- Islington Boat Club's first base was here. It is now on the opposite side of the basin.
- City Road Basin, previously City Basin.
- The 4 acre basin originally extended under City Road. In 1979, it was filled in reducing its length by quarter.
- International Harvester, based here from 1910, assembled tractors for agricultural use.
